DL454-02 – Renishaw’s policy for China RoHS 2

Effective 01 July 2016 the Chinese Ministry of Industry and Information Technology (MIIT) released “Order No.32 – Administrative Measures for the restriction of the use of Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Products (EEP)”, known as China RoHS 2 (The Measures).

In relation to the first phase of The Measures (defined in SJ/T 11364-2014 Marking for the Restricted Use of Hazardous Substances in Electronic and Electrical Products), Renishaw’s Encoder product lines fall within the definition of “EEP that are purchased for manufacturing” and, as such, do not require markings. In accordance with section 4.0 of SJ/T 11364-2014, data to support the marking of complete machinery will be supplied on demand in the form of a substance declaration table as defined in section 6.2.2.

All other products will be assessed and marked according to The Measures and required information supplied in the form of a substance declaration table.

The second phase of The Measures was triggered by the release of the China RoHS2 catalogue, which provides a listing of in-scope products coming into force from 12th March 2019. Renishaw has reviewed this catalogue and concludes that Renishaw has no in-scope branded products.
